


SELF-REFLECTION TOOLS FOR SMART UNIVERSITIES ACTING REGIONALLY

The tool "HEInnovate for RIS3", developed by RE-ACT, aims to complement the HEInnovate tool by integrating statements dedicated to the Research and Innovation Strategy for Smart Specialisation (RIS3).

Based on the concept of collaboration among the actors of the Quadruple Helix, this tool allows HEIs to self-reflect and assess their contribution to RIS3, helping them to understand, among other issues, how well they fulfil their mission and reach out to others.
