## 2. LEGISLATION ON WHICH THE DATA PROCESSING IS BASED

- Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 April 2016 on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data, and repealing Regulation (EC) No 95/46/EC (General Data Protection Regulation): GDPR);
- Act CXII of 2011 on informational self-determination and the freedom of information;
- Act V of 2013 on the Civil Code.

The call for competition will be published on 06.04.2023. The Corvinus slogan must be submitted by 20 April 2023 using an online form. Selection of winners: first, a committee of Corvinus Communication members will select the 3 best ideas by 19 May 2023. The Organiser will publish the name of the winners and the submitted ideas and notify the winners on 22 May 2023.

The Organiser is liable to pay contributions in respect of the prize and is therefore also entitled to process personal data as defined in the applicable tax legislation.

#### 4. ACCESS TO AND TRANSFER OF DATA

Only CORVINUS staff responsible for organising and conducting the prize competition may have access to the personal data provided in paragraph 3.

The University will only disclose personal data to third parties with the consent of the data subject or in the case of a legal authorisation or obligation.

The Organiser will not pass on the personal data of the data subject to any third parties and will not use a data processor. Personal data will not be transferred to third countries.

The University is entitled to publish the name of the winner within the University.

# 5. DATA SECURITY MEASURES

The University stores personal data on the University servers. The University does not use the services of another company to store the data. The University shall take appropriate measures to ensure that personal data are protected against, inter alia, unauthorised access, and to ensure the continued confidentiality, integrity, availability and resilience of the systems and services used to process personal data, and the ability to restore in a timely manner access to and availability of personal data in the event of a physical or technical incident.

## 6. RIGHTS IN RELATION TO DATA PROCESSING

The data subject has the right to request information about the data processing, the right to obtain rectification of data -and to data portability, in case odf data processed on the grounds of consent- , data blocking (restriction of data processing) as well as to request the data processor to provide him/her information on his/her personal data and information relating to the processing thereof. If the data subject's consent constitutes the ground for processing,

the data subject may withdraw his or her consent at any time. Withdrawal of consent does not affect the lawfulness of the data processing that took place before the withdrawal. The data subject may exercise his or her rights under this section by sending a request to the adatvedelem@uni-corvinus.hu e-mail address.

## 7. LEGAL ENFORCEMENT IN RELATION TO DATA PROCESSING

In the event of unlawful processing, the data subject may refer the matter to the CORVINUS Data Protection Officer, the National Authority for Data Protection and Freedom of Information (NAIH) or a court.
