2. LEGISLATION ON WHICH THE DATA PROCESSING IS BASED

- Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 April 2016 on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data, and repealing Directive 95/46/EC (General Data Protection Regulation: GDPR);
- Act CXII of 2011 on informational self-determination and freedom of information

3. SUBJECT MATTER, SCOPE, PURPOSE AND DURATION OF DATA PROCESSING

The journal “Pénzügyi Szemle”, published by CORVINUS, offers authors the opportunity to publish their papers. The decision of publication is taken by a reviewers’ board. The present Data Processing Notice provides information on the processing of personal data of authors and reviewers in accordance with Article 13 of the GDPR.

4. ACCESS TO DATA AND DATA TRANSFER

The data may be accessed by the staff members of CORVINUS engaged editing and publishing the journal “Pénzügyi Szemle” for the purpose of performing their duties and to the extent necessary therefor. With the exception set out in this section, the University shall only disclose data to third parties on the basis of a legal authorisation or with the consent of the data subject.

5. ENGAGING A DATA PROCESSOR

CORVINUS does not use a data processor in connection with the processing of data under this Data Processing Notice.

6. DATA SECURITY MEASURES

The University shall store the personal data on the University servers. The University shall not use any other company’s services for storing the data. The University shall take appropriate measures to ensure that the personal data are protected against, inter alia, unauthorised access, and to ensure the continued confidentiality, integrity, availability and resilience of the systems and services used to process personal data, and the ability to restore in a timely manner access to and availability of personal data in the event of a physical or technical incident.

7. RIGHTS IN RELATION TO DATA PROCESSING

The data subject has the right to request information about the data processing, the right to obtain rectification of data -and to data portability, in case of data processed on the grounds of consent- , data blocking (restriction of data processing), to object to the processing of his/her data as well as to request the data processor to provide him/her information on his/her personal data and information relating to the processing thereof. If the data subject’s consent constitutes the ground for processing, the data subject may withdraw his or her consent at any time. The withdrawal of consent shall not affect the lawfulness of data processing that took place before the withdrawal. 8. LEGAL ENFORCEMENT IN RELATION TO DATA PROCESSING

In the event of unlawful data processing, the data subject may refer the matter to the CORVINUS Data Protection Officer, the National Authority for Data Protection and Freedom of Information (NAIH) or a court.
