Moodle

Moodle is the e-learning management system used by Corvinus University. This is the online Learning Platform / Course Management System that most professors use to share course materials with the students.

When?

You will be able to log into the Moodle system after you have registered in CUSMAN, as you will need to use the same login details. Please note that the Moodle platform will be activated around the start of the orientation period, therefore you won't be able to use it earlier.

Why is it important?

The majority of your professors will use Moodle throughout the semester. Updated course syllabi, lecture slides, training materials, presentations, assignments, etc. are usually uploaded on Moodle. You may also be asked to upload written assignments, group projects there, as well.

Moodle can also be used as an online testing platform (quizzes, midterms, end-of-the-semester exams).

Please be aware: Professors can check Moodle to see how many times you have accessed the course site, whether you have checked out the additional course materials uploaded, and they can also run any uploaded assignments through Urkund (the plagiarism checker connected to Moodle and used by Corvinus professors), etc.

Where?
