How to obtain a permanent student ID?



How to request a student ID?

STEP 1: obtain NEK identifier

To submit your request you need your **NEK identifier** (NEK is for the Hungarian Unified Card System) which can be obtained at the <u>Governmental Offices</u> (Okmányiroda in Hungarian) free of charge.

Necessary documents for NEK application:

- passport or ID
- residence permit and address card

Select an office and pick the option diákigazolvány (= student card).

You will need to have your photo taken and sign an application. You will receive a "**NEK-code**" (circled in red) that you must register in Neptun.



IMPORTANT: **the personal information** (your name, your mother's maiden name, your birth place) **have to be exactly the same as in Neptun**. Any difference can cause administration problems which could delay the manufacturing of your permanent Student ID Card.

Your <u>NEK datasheet</u> (see for reference) is valid for 5 years and can be used for other applications (if it has been lost then it can be replaced free of charge).



New NEK application is necessary if any of your personal data has been changed or your photo or your signature is expired.

STEP 2: registering the NEK code in Neptun

Your NEK identifier and checking your Neptun data are needed.

Request can be submitted in Neptun:

- ► Go to NEPTUN -> Menu -> Administration -> Student Card Request
- ► Register your NEK-code.
- ▶ This will be on the right side of the NEK document you receive.
- ► Enter the numbers and letters only.
- ► Choose: First Application
- ► Confirm your permanent address in your home country and save it.

It takes usually a couple of months to have your student-card delivered. Do check meanwhile Neptun for possible error messages. More information <u>here</u>.

STEP 3: apply for temporary student certificate

You can request a temporary student certificate from your Study Coordinator whilst you wait for the permanent card (which takes around 2-4 months).

Note that the university will provide you with a temporary student certificate (which can be used for reduced price public transportation ticket, etc.) **only after you have applied and registered for a permanent student ID**.

The temporary student ID is valid for a **maximum of 60 days**. You should request another one if it expires before your permanent card arrives to the University.





Observations:

- It is **only valid in Hungary**!
- It is issued by Corvinus
- -You must **have it with you at all times** in order to use student benefits/discounts (public transportation pass, movies, gym, restaurants, stc)
- Request a new temporary student certificate at least 1 week before it expires!

STEP 4: validation of the student ID

When you receive your permanent student ID card, you must get it validated by your Programme Coordinator.

Your student ID card can be validated term by term (each semester) with holographic stickers available during opening hours. The sticker can be received only if it is stuck onto your card by a coordinator after you signed that you received it.

Please note that the sticker can be received only if your term status is active (it'll not be available if it is passive).

Without the sticker your ID is not valid! Pay attention to it as you may get fined on the traffic transportation without it!
