Prerequisites and language requirements

- 60 ECTS credits first cycle/undergraduate/bachelor courses. See syllabi for specifications.
- Fluency in English: The home university guarantees a student's fluency in English. Read more about the language requirements here: language requirements.

Tuition fees and costs

- Tuition fees: 25 000 SEK (In general, individuals who are citizens of countries outside of the European Union (EU), European Economic Area (EEA) and Switzerland are required to pay application and tuition fees). Read more here about application and tuition fees.
- Application fee: 900 SEK (All Swedish Universities charge a mandatory application fee of 900 SEK (approx. 80 Euro) to citizens outside the European Union (EU), European Economic Area (EEA) and Switzerland to process and review an application). Read more here about application and tuition fees.
- Accommodation: Between 3500 500 SEK per month



The total costs of the Summer course is **32,500 SEK** including tuition fees, accommodation, company visits, welcome lunch, farewell dinner, certificate ceremony, social and cultural activities such as a trip to one of Sweden's best-preserved castles from the 16th century in Vadstena, a trip to Gränna; a charming city where traditional Swedish peppermint candy canes are handmade, a visit to the ruins of Brahehus Castle, after-school activities, a Swedish Midsummer celebration and much more!
