

Pannónia scoring system

Scoring of the 2025/2026 academic year applications will be based on a 70-30% ratio of points, based on the following:

1. Points gained from study results can be a maximum of 70. The basis of the scoring system is the cumulative adjusted credit index, which takes into account the grades of all semesters. When calculating the index, the denominator includes both the registered and completed credits, therefore unsuccessful subjects are also considered.
2. Extracurricular activities are worth 30 points maximum. The points for the subcategories are maximised.

The total of 30 points for extracurricular activities are sorted into the following, maximalised subcategories:

- TDK activities, other study competitions, case competitions, idea competitions: 19 points maximum
- Demonstrator activities supporting education; participation in department tasks as demonstrators: 10 points maximum
- Participation in events assisting the integration of international students: 10 points maximum
- Participation in student associations and colleges for advanced studies: 15 points maximum

Students beginning their studies in the current academic year are subject to the same scoring system as those who have started their studies in earlier years.

Student association and colleges for advanced studies can be considered for students who have not conducted their BSc studies at Corvinus. External activities are scored based on the criteria for category B1.

Attendance at competitions, in talent fostering and summer universities must be proven by a written and signed certificate issued by the host institution.

The 50 points from these subcategories are then ratioed to 30 points.

Subcategories for extracurricular activities:

TDK activities, other study competitions, case competitions, idea competitions: 19 points maximum

In case of TDK activities, a maximum of two different essays can be considered.

(For TDK and OTDK activities, only the highest score can be considered)

Completing university courses outside of classes, student associations and colleges for advanced studies: 3 points per course
Participation in talent fostering events not organised by student associations and colleges for advanced studies (e.g. Nyugat Társaság, Leaders of the future): 3 points per program
Participation in summer universities: 3 points (Maximum one summer university can be considered, to be verified by submitting a transcript issued by the host university)
Total: 19 points maximum

Demonstrator activities supporting education; participation in department tasks as demonstrators (2 courses maximum can be considered): 10 points maximum

Available scores
Demonstrator activities supporting education; participation in department tasks as demonstrators
Maximum two courses can be considered (2 semesters can be considered) -> 10 points max.
Total: 10 points maximum

Participation in programs assisting the integration of international students: 6 points maximum

10-8 points: 3 points
7-5 points: 2 points

Participation in the organisation of the events of the CEMS Club
Maximum 3 points per semester (a maximum of 2 occasions can be considered)
Student Union International Area
Area manager, coordinator: 3 points
Members: 2 points
Total: 6 points maximum

Student association and colleges for advanced studies participation: 15 points maximum

At most, 2 student associations and/or colleges for advanced studies can be considered.

The highest position in one organisation is considered for the applicants.

Student association member: 3 points
Activities in category B2 student associations:
Student association upper management: 6 points
Student association middle management: 4 points
Student association member: 2 points
Total: 15 points maximum
