## DATA PROCESSING NOTICE on data processing in connection with the "Lecturer of the Semester Gala" staged by the Corvinus University of Budapest (20 Jan 2025- 21 Feb 2025)

#### 2. LEGISLATION ON WHICH THE DATA PROCESSING IS BASED

- Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 April 2016 on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data, and repealing Regulation (EC) No 95/46/EC (General Data Protection Regulation): GDPR);
- Act CXII of 2011 on informational self-determination and the freedom of information;

# 3. THE SCOPE OF THE DATA PROCESSED AND THE PURPOSE OF DATA PROCESSING

CORVINUS will organise the "Lecturer of the Semester Gala" in the second semester of the 2024/2025 academic year, during which students can nominate the best lecturers in eight categories during the nomination period from 20 to 26 Jan 2025 and vote for them in the voting period.

From the nominations submitted online, the University will compile for each category a list of the five lecturers who received the highest number of nominations..

Students will also vote online for the winner in each category from the five nominated lecturers.

The University will announce the winners of the lecturer categories at an event, through a news item on the website and a post. Winning lecturers will receive a prize.

Data subjects (hereinafter: Data Subject): In each case, the university students participating in the nomination and voting, the university lecturers nominated and voted for.

The present Data Processing Notice provides information on the processing of data in the context of the "Lecturer of the Semester Gala" in accordance with Article 13 of the GDPR.

### 4. ACCESS TO AND TRANSFER OF DATA

The data may be accessed by the staff members of CORVINUS, in particular by those of Corvinus Communication and by the members of the Student Union for the purpose of performing their duties and to the extent necessary therefor.

The University will only disclose data to third parties on the basis of a legal authorisation or with the consent of the data subject.

### **5. ENGAGING A DATA PROCESSOR**

The University does not use a data processor to process the data.

## 6. DATA SECURITY MEASURES

The University stores personal data on the University servers. The University does not use the services of another company to store the data. The University shall take appropriate measures to ensure that personal data are protected against, inter alia, unauthorised access, and to ensure the continued confidentiality, integrity, availability and resilience of the systems and services used to process personal data, and the ability to restore in a timely manner access to and availability of personal data in the event of a physical or technical incident.

## 7. RIGHTS IN RELATION TO DATA PROCESSING

The Data Subject has the right to request information about the data processing, the right to obtain rectification of data, the right to obtain blocking (restriction of data processing) and may request the data controller to make available his or her personal data and information relating to the data processing thereof. The data subject may withdraw his/her consent at any time. Withdrawal of consent does not affect the lawfulness of the data processing that took place before the withdrawal. The data subject may request the porting of his/her data as well as may object to the processing of his or her data. The Data Subject may exercise his or her rights under this section by sending an e-mail to the hok@uni-corvinus.hu address.

## 8. LEGAL ENFORCEMENT IN RELATION TO DATA PROCESSING

In the event of unlawful processing, the Data Subject may refer the matter to the CORVINUS Data Protection Officer, the National Authority for Data Protection and Freedom of Information (NAIH) or a court.
