

Comprehensive/Complex examination June or at the end of August 2025

Comprehensive examination ends the study and research phase



120 credits must be obtained by the end of May

Minimum 6 teaching credits, minimum 48 study maximum 60 credits (core courses, core elective courses, elective courses), 60 research credits

Comprehensive examination consists of two main part: theoritical-methodological (research plan) and dissertation (20-30 min presentation)



Theoretical part (submitted written research plan)

- to demonstrate the methodological background of the research
- to demonstrate the scientific context of the research topic
- to formulate the personal reasons for the choice of the *topic*, its *topicality*, *social*, *economic* and *environmental* context, the research objectives and the research questions
- to disclose basic ideas on research methodology (to justify the selected methodology, supported by academic literature, seeks to present the full array of methodological tools he/she wishes to use later (qualitative, quantitative or mixed methods, data recording and data analysis tools etc.))
- to prepare a critical literature review of the research topic.
- The length of the body text shall be a minimum of 20 pages (+ title page, table of contents, bibliography, annexes), 2.5 cm margins, using single spacing, font size 12 TNR, paragraphs separated by indentation
- The research methodology section must be at least 10 pages long.

Dissertation part (Oral examination, presentation)

Give a 15-20 minues presentation, 10-12 slides



- Demonstrate convincing knowledge of the skills acquired during the qualitative and/or quantitative methodology courses and to be used in the dissertation in progress, as well as should be able to adapt that knowledge to the field of specialisation.
- Present the research activities and results in addition the research schedule for the second phase of doctoral studies, and the timetable for the preparation and publication of the doctoral dissertation.
- The board asks questions about the contents of the presentation. In this phase, the supervisor is allowed to assess the candidate's work completed so far (max 5 minutes)
